

## **KYC Sole proprietors**

We refer to a **SOLE PROPRIETOR** or a sole trader as a natural person (i.e. not a legally constituted person or a form of legal arrangements such as partnerships or trust) who trades for his or her own benefit. The trading operation (the **SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP**) and all legal rights and obligations flowing from that operation form part of the sole proprietors own personal estate.

#### How to submit documentation for our records:

Copies of documents that we need you to provide us with for our records can be certified by a commissioner of oaths. Alternatively the originals of the documents you present to us will be returned after being verified and copied by an FNB Staff member.

## 1. WE REQUEST THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS FROM YOU AS THE SOLE PROPRIETOR

a) Identification documents:

#### Namibian residents:

A Namibian Identity Document A Valid Namibian Passport Birth Certificate for a minor.

#### **Foreign National Persons:**

A valid foreign passport <u>including</u> a copy of the relevant permit or visa (must include "business" if trading in Namibia)

Documents issued by the Receiver of Revenue reflecting your income tax number (if applicable).

# 2. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FROM KYC RELATED PARTIES OF YOUR SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP The following persons are Related Parties of your Sole Proprietorship:

The Sole Proprietor themselves:

Any other natural person that you authorize to establish a business relationship or enter into a single transaction with the Bank on your behalf including people who you appoint as your authorized representative and account users.

## **Foreign National Persons:**

A valid foreign passport
